Daily Itinerary

June 9 – Depart Lynchburg for an overnight stay in Ohio. Breakfast and lunch en-route.

June 10 – After breakfast, travel to Frankenmuth, Michigan. For decades, Frankenmuth has been known for chicken and Christmas and it's no wonder with "Bronner's", the world's largest Christmas store, and one of the largest independently owned restaurants in the country- "the Bavarian Inn"- that serve world famous chicken dinners. Enjoy time to browse around this German town, as well as feast on the included authentic dinner at Bavarian Inn. Rest tonight with an overnight stay.

June 11 – After breakfast travel from Frankenmuth to Mackinaw City located on Lake Huron, enjoy a two night stay. This afternoon enjoy a sightseeing tour of Mackinaw City including the famous Mackinac Bridge. (This Bridge is one of the world's most beautiful bridges and the longest suspension bridge in America, with a total length of 8,614 feet suspended) Mackinaw City has so much to offer, there is something for everyone. June 12 – After breakfast, journey by ferry over to the beautiful Mackinac Island.
